Changes to the Board of Directors of Cornèr Bank

Today's General Meeting of Shareholders of Cornèr Bank Ltd. saw the request of Vice Chairman Dr Luigi Dell'Acqua not to renew his term of office accepted. He leaves the Board of Directors after 11 years of service and a career spanning over 50 years with the Lugano-based Bank. Lawyer Pierpaolo Caldelari has been elected as his replacement.

Luigi Dell'Acqua has had a long career at Cornèr Bank, which he joined in 1968. He shared the leadership of the Bank with his brother-in-law Paolo Cornaro from 1989 to 2007. They both took over the inheritance left by the founder Vittorio Cornaro. The Board acknowledged the role played by Luigi Dell'Acqua in the growth of the Bank, as well as his wonderful professional and personal qualities, and expressed its heartfelt gratitude and appreciation for his contribution.

Pierpaolo Caldelari now sits on the Board of Directors of Cornèr Bank Ltd. as one of the 10 members. He is a lawyer with a proven track record and an in-depth knowledge of the banking sector and the Lugano financial centre.

In addition, the Board of Directors has entrusted the role of Vice Chairman to Carlo Donati, who is a member of the Board from 2008.
